Our next priest to be ordained is James Manning who will serve in the benefice of Saint Peter, Bishopsworth and Saint Oswald, Bedminster Down.

"This past year, I have been surprised by God's grace working in me and through me in ways I could not have expected. It has been the kind of experience that I imagine the disciples had when Jesus handed them a basket of subdivided loaves and fish and told them to go and give food to the 5,000-plus crowd in front of them: a feeling of nervousness and trepidation, wondering whether what they had in their basket would be enough to feed those around them as Jesus had told them. This feeling has been how I have felt as I have started a different role, been part of a different church, and got to know a different community in a different part of Bristol. At times, I have been left wondering what I was doing and questioning whether what I had to offer in my basket would be enough, but at each of these moments, I have seen God's grace at work to provide what is needed. I am grateful for the warm welcome by the Church community at St Peter's, and I look forward to this next step and to seeing what God might do in and through us with our small basket of fish and loaves."

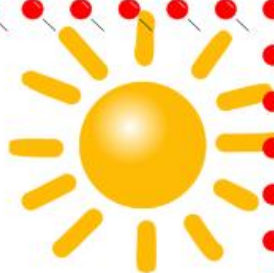

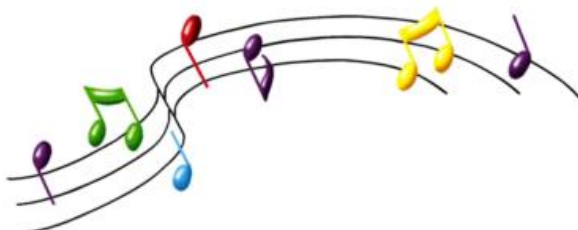
